### Sub: Achievement of milestones & signing of FSA

Dear Sir,

As per Minutes of SLC(LT) Meeting dated 22/23.10.08 (Item No. 2: Review of old cases of CPPs having linkages where coal drawal has not yet commenced nor FSA has been signed) it was decided to conclude FSA in respect of certain CPP units.

Now, vide letter No. 23022/8/2006-CPD(Vol.II)Pt. dated 19.01.2009 issued by MOC & further directives received from CIL in the instant case, it is required to execute the FSA within a period of one month from the date of issuance of this letter. FSA quantity would be **135148 TPA Grade-F** coal. However, since signing of FSA is subject to achievement of milestones applicable for CPPs in accordance with the provisions of New Coal Distribution Policy (NCDP), you are hereby requested to submit all the required documents towards fulfilment of these milestones within 15 days so that the same can be scrutinized and if found in order, then further necessary action can be taken for execution of FSA within stipulated period as above.

The milestones and the documents required to be submitted against each are as per Annexure enclosed. In this connection, further clarifications issued vide Notice No. SECL/BSP/S&M/COMM/358/LOA/3904 dt. 15.01.09 may also please be referred, which is available on SECL website [www.secl.gov.in](http://www.secl.gov.in).
